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Age	Screening Tests/Immunizations
Birth	Hearing screen, PKU and the baby might get Hep B in the hospital
3-5 days	Initial Well Visit-- Growth Chart (GC), Physical Exam (PE), Developmental Eval (DE)
10-14 days	GC, PE, DE, and repeat PKU
1 month	GC, PE, DE, no vaccines
2 months	GC, PE, DE, Pediarix, Prevnar, Hib, Rotavirus
4 months	GC, PE, DE, Pediarix, Prevnar, Hib, Rotavirus
6 months	GC, PE, DE, Pediarix, Prevnar, Hib, Rotavirus *
9 months	GC, PE, DE, *
12 months	GC, PE, DE, TB/Lead screening, MMR, HepA, Prevnar, Lead level, hemoglobin (anemia) level, *DENTAL referral
15 months	GC, PE, DE, TB/Lead screening, Dtap, Hib, Varicella *
18 months	GC, PE, DE, TB/Lead screening, MCHAT screening, HepA*
2 years	GC, PE, DE, TB/Lead screening, lead level, MCHAT screening, hemoglobin (anemia) level*
2.5 years (30 months)	GC, PE, DE, TB/Lead screening (<i>MCHAT screening if missed previously</i>)
3 years	GC, PE, DE, TB/Lead screening, *
4 years	GC, PE, DE, Blood Pressure (BP), TB/Lead screening, Vision screen, Kinrix, Proquad, *
5-10 years	GC, PE, DE, BP, TB/Lead screening, Vision screen, *
11 years	GC, PE, DE, BP, TB/Lead screening, Vision screen, Tdap, MCV, consider guardasil, *
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* yearly flu vaccines are given October through March starting at 6 months (Flu mist is available for children over 2 yrs)

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
